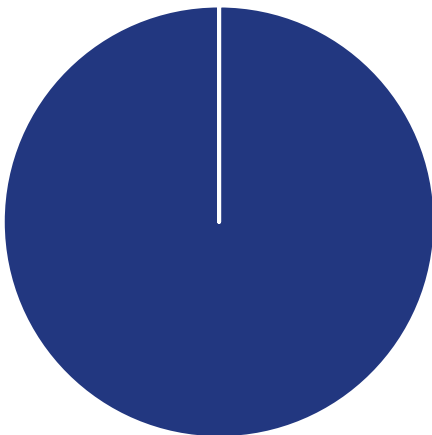

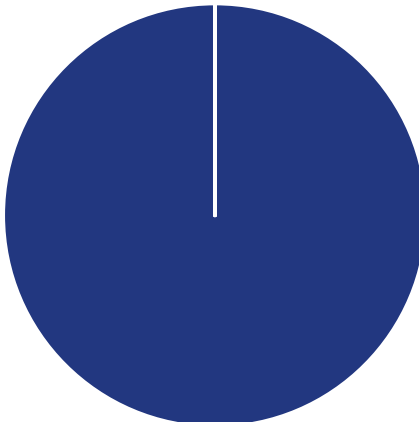
Currency exposure
